GLASGOW AIRPORT RAIL LINK: ENVIRONMENTAL STATEMENT

Historic Scotland is content that the Environmental Statement identifies and addresses the main impacts of this scheme on listed buildings.

- Category A listed Glasgow Central Station

In light of the lack of detail at this stage in relation to the proposed works on the Category A listed Central Station we would wish to be consulted when the works reach a more detailed design stage.

- Category B listed Greenhill Road, Four Square Tobacco Factory

While the significance of the effect on the setting of this building is likely to be moderate in nature we would again wish to be consulted again at the detailed design stage.

We also note that powers are to be sought to make specified alterations to listed buildings through Private Bill legislation. While we are not against the principle of this provision we would wish to be satisfied that a sufficient level of detail is included within the Private Bill. Specifications should be tightly defined within the Private Bill and we would be happy to advise on this.

We can also confirm that the proposal will not impact on Historic Scotland's scheduled ancient monument interests.
